

Battle Of Flowers® Parade And Fiesta Flambeau® Parade Have Been Canceled by the City of San Antonio For 2021

Thank you for your purchase of tickets to our parades. Because of the ongoing pandemic, and the extraordinary safety precautions in planning these events, The Battle of Flowers® Association and The Fiesta Flambeau® Parade Association were forced to cancel their respective parades in 2020. Part of safe planning is re-evaluating whether or not to hold both parades that draw well over one million spectators to the streets of San Antonio for the traditional day and night parades during Fiesta® week. Due to public health safety concerns regarding COVID-19, both organizations have agreed with the City to cancel the 2021 festivities.
